Silver Julep Cups—Keeneland awards the winning owner of all maiden allowance and allowance races a silver julep cup sponsored by the owner of the farm for which the race is named. Julep cups are shipped approximately three weeks from the date of the race.

Track Rules

Seventy-two (72) hour entry rule (except Saturdays for Wednesdays and Sundays for Thursdays). Scratches will be considered by stewards upon submission. Naming of jockeys at time of entry.

No entry shall be accepted from any stable not provided with a trainer's license.

Any persons exercising horses during training hours shall wear a protective helmet and safety vest.

Every horse must be saddled in the paddock. This rule is imperative. Horses must be in the **paddock** at least twenty minutes before the bugle call. Ponies may not accompany horses in the walking ring.

Upon going to the post, all horses **must parade** in front of the stand in the order assigned to them on the official program.

Owners or trainers will be required to deposit **jockey fees** (except those under contract) with the horsemen's bookkeeper by 12:00 noon on the day of the race and upon failure to do so, may be fined or suspended and the horse declared out of the race.

All two-year-olds must be properly **schooled and approved** by the starter before being allowed to start.

No entry will be received except upon the condition that all disputes, claims and objections arising out of the racing or with respect to the interpretation of the conditions of any race shall be decided by the officers of the association, or those whom they may appoint and their decision upon all points shall be final. **At the discretion of the stewards, and without notice**, the entries of any

person, or acceptance or transfer of any entries, may be refused.

The stewards reserve the right to **substitute one jockey for another**, at their discretion. It will be their purpose to substitute a jockey of **equal ability**.

Neat dress required, all trainers and accompanying stable personnel should be neatly dressed when taking horses to the paddock. Pony personnel taking horses to the post in the public parade must wear jackets available at the paddock gate and must keep themselves and their mounts well groomed and their tack clean.

Horseman stabled at Keeneland are, at their own risk, allowed to exercise their horses in the designated field situated behind Barns 46-49. Hours are from sunup to 11:00 a.m. on race days and sunup to noon on non-race days. Trainers are required to have the personnel accompanying the horse to the gallops to sign a waiver of liability with the Racing Secretary prior to using the property. **Outriders will not be provided on the gallops.**

There will be an outrider on the track every day for your protection and if at any time he can be of assistance, do not hesitate to call on him.

Milkshaking

The practice of milkshaking horses entered to compete in races at Keeneland is prohibited. Keeneland reserves the right to perform physiological tests consisting of the taking of blood samples from horses entered in races to be conducted at Keeneland and such samples will be tested for total carbon dioxide concentrations.

Keeneland's House Rule relating to milkshaking contains specific information about testing, levels of total carbon dioxide permitted and the sanctions for violation of the House Rule. Copies of the House Rule may be obtained from Keeneland's Racing Secretary, Director of Racing, Stable Office or the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority's office.

All horses for every race must report to the holding barn (barn 21) forty-five (45) minutes prior to their scheduled post time for TCO₂ testing. Absolutely no unauthorized personnel are allowed within thirty (30) feet of the holding barn. Violators will be reported to the Stewards by Security.

Insurance

All trainers shall furnish Keeneland and/or the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority (KHRA) with proof of insurance for general liability and workers compensation, in such amounts and in such manner as shall be directed by Keeneland and/or KHRA.

Weight

Owners and trainers must be careful to claim allowances at the time of entry, and state penalties, and are solely responsible if a horse starts with the incorrect weight and is therefore disqualified.

In all races of one (1) mile or over, other than maiden, stakes or handicaps, any horse which has never won at a distance of one (1) mile or over, shall be allowed three (3) pounds weight allowance in addition to any other allowances for which it may be entitled in the race; such allowance shall be claimed at time of entry.

Trainers on his behalf and as agent for the owner(s) of all horses stabled at Keeneland under the care of the trainer hereby agrees to the following terms and conditions in consideration of the permission of Keeneland Association, Inc. for the stabling of the horses of the trainer at Keeneland for the Fall race meeting.

Keeneland Management reserves the right to refuse stabling space, or to refuse the acceptance of any entry in any race for any reason or cause, and without notice to the trainer.

Trainers agree to abide by all rules and regulations of Keeneland and the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority.

Trainers agree to vacate stalls and move all horses, equipment, and personnel, upon request, from Keeneland property within a reasonable time.

All Kentucky Horse Racing Authority Licensees, including but not limited to the host association, Keeneland Association Inc. ("Keeneland"), owners, trainers, jockeys and grooms ("Licensees"), participating in stabling, racing, training and related activities at Keeneland recognize that hazards and risks inherent in such activities may cause the injury or death of horses. Therefore, in

consideration of participating in stabling, racing, training and related activities at Keeneland, all Licensees assume the risks of, and release, hold harmless and covenant **not to sue all other Licensees so participating for (i) ordinary negligence which causes or contributes to loss, loss of use, injury or damage to horses while on the premises of Keeneland and (ii) ordinary negligence which causes or contributes to personal injury or property damage, including but not limited to loss, loss of use, injury or damage to horses arising from the use of grass fields ("gallops")** owned or controlled by Keeneland, whether arising from alleged acts or omissions of a Licensee and its agents or employees, the condition of the premises of Keeneland, or any other cause. Except as provided above, all Licensees participating in racing, training and related activities at Keeneland shall be responsible for their own acts and omissions and those of their agents and employees to the same extent as provided by law.

All stable reservations made, and every entry in any race will be accepted only on the condition that all disputes, claims and objections arising out of the racing or with respect to the interpretation of any rules or conditions or races or otherwise shall be decided by the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority, Stewards of the meeting or Keeneland, and such decision upon all points shall be final.

Keeneland reserves the right to start any or all races with or without a stall gate starting machine.

Horses claimed, transferred or sold to any person or stable, not registered for racing at Keeneland, must be removed from the grounds within twenty-four (24) hours, unless approved by the Stewards and Keeneland.

Trainers accept the responsibility for all persons for whom he is acting with regard to the rules and regulations of the race meeting conditions of Keeneland, and the rules of racing adopted by the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority, and agrees to be bound by and comply with the same, and the acts and decisions of the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority and the Racing Officials.

Surveillance

By entering any horse(s), owner, trainer, their respective agents, employees and affiliates ("Entrant") acknowledge and agree that Keeneland has the right to inspect and maintain surveillance on all horses located at Keeneland, including,

without limitation, horse's stall, barn and all grounds in general proximity to the physical location of the horse as Keeneland selects and deems appropriate in its sole discretion.

Ship Ins

Entrant further agrees that any horse running at Keeneland will be on Keeneland's grounds a minimum of four (4) hours prior to race time in default of which Entrant understands that the horse shall be scratched.

Special Notices

All stalls must be bedded with straw.

All water hoses must be fitted with a nozzle that shuts off automatically upon release.

All dogs must be kept inside tack rooms during training and racing hours, or if out, must be leashed and in hand at all times. Under no circumstances may dogs be tied in shedrows or about the barns during these hours. Dogs tied in shedrows at hours other than the above mentioned must be on a fixed, short leash to permit free access and passage of Keeneland's security police around the barn area. No running chains or lines will be permitted. This action is being taken in order to permit the daily routine business of veterinarians, blacksmiths, feedmen, track security, deliveries and barn maintenance personnel.

Television Rights

Keeneland may televise (film or tape), or authorize or license the televising of certain horse racing to be conducted in its racing plant from time to time, and accordingly, it hereby reserves television rights, whether in connection with any race, preparations therefor, or ceremonies or proceedings thereafter, or training at the track. This application is accepted on the condition that, if required, consent is hereby given, and the owner, jockey, trainer, groom and all other employees of the owner coming within the view of the television picture hereby agree to sign and deliver to Keeneland upon demand releases permitting such television and the exhibition thereof.

Investigative Reports for Employment

In making an application for employment or to otherwise participate in Thoroughbred racing, it is understood that an investigative report may be obtained

through personal interviews with third parties, such as family members, business associates, financial sources, friends, neighbors, or others with whom you are acquainted. This inquiry includes information as to your character, general reputation, personal characteristics, and mode of living, which may be applicable. You have the right to make a written request within a reasonable period of time for a complete and accurate disclosure of additional information concerning the nature and scope of the investigation.

Coggins Tests and Health Certificates

All horses, including leading ponies, seeking entrance into our stable area(s) shall be accompanied by a current negative Coggins Test dated less than one year prior to date of arrival, and listed on a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI), which has been signed and dated within seventy two (72) hours prior to arrival by a licensed veterinarian.

Additionally, each horse seeking entrance into our stable area shall be vaccinated against Equine Herpes Virus Type 1 (EHV-1) by a licensed veterinarian a minimum of fourteen (14) days, and no more than ninety (90) days of entry into our stable area(s). The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) shall indicate the date of the vaccination, the specific vaccine product, vaccine lot number, and vaccine expiration date, used to vaccinate each horse.

Preferred List

Horses which have been excluded from races shall be given preference the next time they are entered, provided they are entered in a race of similar distance (under a mile or over) and within a price range of \$500 either way up to \$8,000; above that \$1,000 either way up to \$15,000; above that \$2,500 either way up to \$25,000, and above that \$5,000. Fillies and mares and turf will be kept separate.

Horses excluded from allowance races will receive a star for the condition of the race in which they were entered. Those stars are not transferable to any other condition race. This also includes book races that fail to fill.

Winners are preferred in all Polytrack races.

STAR ONLY entries will be accepted in two-year-old maiden races only. Trainers may enter up to three star only entries. However, should the race not

overfill no stars will be allotted.

Condition Eligibility

Horses are preferred by their available conditions beginning with Graded stake winners (Grade I-II-III-Stakes winners-Restricted Stakes winners) through their allowance conditions downward through maiden then maiden claiming, providing the horse has won for more than \$25,000 since starting for \$25,000 or less. Starter races for \$25,000 or less will be considered claiming races for condition eligibility.

Polytrack Surface

In the summer of 2006, Keeneland Race Course installed a Polytrack surface, making it the third North American racetrack to install Polytrack as its main racing surface. Turfway Park, in Northern Kentucky, installed Polytrack in the summer of 2005, followed by Woodbine Racetrack in the summer 2006. Keeneland installed Polytrack on its 5/8 mile training track in September 2004. Polytrack is an entire system, encompassing a specially designed top layer that works in tandem with a unique vertical drainage structure. The top layer—comprised of silica sand, fibers and recycled materials—provides a soft cushion for the horse and rider. It is covered in a wax coating that allows water to flow freely through the top surface to the sub layers below and helps avoid a freezing or inconsistent racetrack—even in inclement weather. The sub layers include porous macadam and dense aggregate rock that provide a solid foundation while vertical drainage pipes carry water away from the track. Together, these elements provide a safer, more consistent racing surface compared to a conventional dirt track.

Turf Course

All races programmed to be run on the turf course may, in the event of a change in the condition of the course, be transferred and run over the main track.

All races transferred from the turf course to the main track will be run at the same distance with these exceptions; races at one mile will be contested at one mile and one-sixteenth and races at one mile and one-half on the turf will be contested at one mile and five-eighths on the main track.

Ponies will not be allowed on the turf course.

The turf course will be open for a limited number of workouts immediately after the main track is closed on Mondays and Thursdays.

Workouts will be limited to horses who are nominated (nominations closed) to stakes races on the turf at Keeneland.

Turf slips must be picked up at the racing secretary's office 24 hours in advance of the workout.

All horses must work outside "dogs" in a counterclockwise direction. Fields will be limited to ten horses on the Keeneland Course (rail at 15 feet) and the Association reserves the right to limit the field size to twelve horses on the Haggin Course.

"Turf stars" will be kept separate from "Polytrack stars."

Shoes for Turf Course

Shoes with caulks, stickers, blocks, raised toes or turndowns will not be allowed on the turf course. This includes quarter horseshoes or any shoe with a toe grab of more than one-quarter inch.

Shoes for Polytrack

Turndowns, quarter horseshoes or any shoe with a toe grab of more than one-quarter inch will not be allowed on Polytrack for training or racing.

Horses requiring the use of medication, drugs or substances to prevent Exercise Induced Pulmonary Hemorrhaging (EIPH)/bleeding, must be registered as such with the KHRA veterinarian. Horses so registered shall remain, and removal requires KHRA veterinarian approval. After inclusion no additional notification shall be required. Horses not properly registered will not be permitted to race with anti bleeder medications, drugs, or substances. Registration must be made prior to entry. The racing program will indicate usage.

Lasix Regulation Explanation

1. To run your horse on Lasix:
 - A. If your horse's previous start was on Lasix in Kentucky and you wish to run on Lasix enter on Lasix.
 - B. If your horse has never run on Lasix in Kentucky, or your horse is a first time starter enter on Lasix.
2. All changes thereafter must be approved by the stewards and/or KHRA veterinarian prior to entry.

Workouts

A horse which has not started in the past forty-five (45) days shall not be permitted to start unless it has at least one published work out within twenty (20) days of entry at a distance satisfactory to the stewards of the meeting. A horse starting for the first time shall not be permitted to start unless it has three (3) published work outs, one of which is from the starting gate, and one which is within twenty (20) days of entry.

Tattooing

Owners' accounts will be billed sixty dollars (\$60) for each horse tattooed by a TRPB tattoo technician during Keeneland's race meet. If the tattooed horse's first career start is at Keeneland, the owner's account will be reimbursed for the tattoo fee.

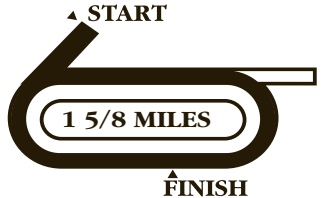

The Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund (KTDF)



Horsemen with Kentucky-Sired Kentucky-Breds have more purse money to run for in allowance, non-claiming maiden and stakes races less than \$100,000 added in Kentucky in 2007 through the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund program.

In Allowance Optional Claiming races, horses entered for a claiming price are not eligible for KTDF distribution.

Eligible races can be readily recognized in the stakes and condition books by the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund seal which will appear next to each race in the stakes and condition books.

A horse must be registered prior to time of entry to be eligible to participate in the distribution of Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund monies.

All horses of racing age that are both Kentucky-Bred and sired by a Kentucky stallion which stood in Kentucky the entire breeding season the year the horse was conceived are eligible to be registered. Owners of horses of racing age are responsible for registering their horses. Stallion owners are responsible for registering their stallions.

Registration applications may also be obtained from the License Office of the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority or the horse identifier.

For those horses that are registered and eligible according to the condition listed above, fund monies will be divided as follows: 65% to winner, 20% to second, 10% to third and 5% to fourth.

Unearned fund monies revert to the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund.

Breeders' Cup Stakes



STAKES

The Breeders' Cup is Thoroughbred racing's only year-round national stakes program. In addition to providing racing's year-end championship, Breeders' Cup Limited funds an extensive number of stakes races throughout the year. Owners and nominators of Breeders' Cup horses can earn additional purse money in Breeders' Cup Stakes races at tracks across the United States and Canada. These purse enhancements are generated by the annual nominations of stallions and the one-time nomination of foals.

Breeders' Cup funds will be paid out in accordance with the track's normal purse distribution schedule. For example, if the track's purse is paid down five places, then the Breeders' Cup amount will also be paid down five places. Only Breeders' Cup-nominated horses will be eligible to run for the additional Breeders' Cup funds. Unearned Breeders' Cup funds revert back to Breeders' Cup Limited.

In addition to the purse payouts a 5% Nominator Award will be paid to the foal and stallion nominator of a Breeders' Cup-nominated horse which finished first, second or third. Stallion Nominator Awards will be paid regardless of the nominations status of a horse finishing first, second or third. These awards are distributed by Breeders' Cup Limited. Owners' purse money is distributed by the track and included in the lifetime earnings of the horse.

The 5% Nominator Award is based on the first, second or third place percentage of the Breeders' Cup purse amount. For instance, if the Breeders' Cup portion of the total purse is \$50,000 and your first place horse received 60% of the \$50,000 or \$30,000, the 5% nominator award would be \$1,500. Nominator awards are paid to both foal nominators and stallion nominators.
