(Includes \$75,000 from Breeders' Cup Fund)

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$12,500 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees.) \$1,250 to enter and an additional \$1,250 to start with \$175,000 guaranteed. This race includes an additional \$75,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for Nominees only. Keeneland Association money to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally among sixth through last. Breeders' Cup Fund money also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup Nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup money not awarded reverts back to the Fund. Weight: Three-year-olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I in 2009 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade II in 2009, 4 lbs; a Grade III or \$60,000 twice in 2009, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Phoenix will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen horses pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference to graded stakes winners, then highest earnings in 2009. Preference will be given to Breeders' Cup Nominees only of equal weight assignment. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup and a Breeders' Cup Trophy to be presented to the winner.
