ALL HORSES MUST REPORT TO BARN 21 FORTY (40) MINUTES PRIOR TO POST-TIME FOR TC02 TESTING. KEENELAND WILL TEST A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) COMPLETE RACES EACH DAY WITH ALL HORSES IN THE SELECTED RACES TESTED.

No paddock schooling after 10:00 am. There will be no schooling allowed during stakes races. Contact the paddock judge for schooling arrangements.
